ECITB CCNSG Construction Safety Passport

The ECITB Client/Contractor National Safety Group (CCNSG) Construction Safety Passport Scheme is a nationally recognised qualification which is frequently specified as a requirement for contractors who wish to work on construction and engineering sites. This course is designed to provide delegates with an enhanced awareness of health and safety, which is delivered through face-to-face training, delegate discussion, and shared experiences, followed by a knowledge test. On successful completion, the delegate will be awarded a CCNSG Safety Passport Card (valid for three years).

This course is suitable for all members of the workforce, this nationally recognised course helps to reduce accidents and lost time incidents on sites.
