ECITB CCNSG Construction Safety Passport Renewal

The Client/Contractor National Safety Group (CCNSG) Safety Passport Scheme is a nationally recognised qualification which is frequently specified as a requirement for contractors who wish to work on construction and engineering sites.

This refresher/renewal course has been designed to update the delegate with the latest legislative and non-legislative developments. To renew your CCNSG Safety Passport you can opt for either attending a Renewal Course or sitting the Test-only for Renewal. On successful completion, the delegate will be awarded a CCNSG Safety Passport Card (valid for three years).
